



Relative Income Poverty, 18-65y, 1990-2019, AROP60, OECD







Social Spending/GDP






Not (only) a matter of choice

- ⇒ Unequal <u>distribution of jobs</u> among <u>individuals</u>
- ⇒ Unequal distribution of jobs among households
- ⇒ Sluggish growth of <u>low earnings</u>
- ⇒ Poverty reduction through work & social security under structural pressure

1. Unequal distribution of jobs among *individuals*, employment rates low and high skilled




2.Unequal distribution of jobs among households






3. The great decoupling between productivity and profit gains





Decreasing impact of social transfers on poverty reduction





A NECESSITY for a just transition

- Raising & indexing the floor: higher minimum wages & partial basic income
- Jobs in the third sector, social & ecological innovation
- Fair distribution of the ageing cost
- Wealth taxation
